

American Dream Scholarship Application

The American Dream Scholarship is available to students who enrolled at Oakton Community College immediately following their 2014 (or later) high school graduation from an accredited high school or GED completion. Students who have attended another college prior to Oakton are not eligible for the scholarship.

Return this completed form to the Enrollment Center, Room 1860 (Des Plaines) or Room A100 (Skokie).

Eligibility Requirements

- Has a Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) status, International Student Visa, or undocumented status.
- Enroll and maintain at least half time enrollment. A minimum of six credits in the fall and spring semesters, and a minimum of three credits in the summer semesters. (*Students should be aware that periodic checks will be made to ensure that the student is actively enrolled in classes*).
- Demonstrate progress in completing his/her academic plan.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 for all coursework completed at Oakton or be a new student to Oakton.
- Continue enrollment at Oakton Community College. If a student transfers to another college or “stops out,” excluding summer, the scholarship is terminated. Students who “transfer back” or want to use the award only for summer term are not eligible.

Application Deadline

September 1, 2017 (fall), February 1, 2018 (spring). Applications received late will receive consideration if funds are available.

Award

\$500-\$1,500 annually, not to exceed tuition and fees (registration, activity, construction, and lab/course). Due to limited funding, every request may not be approved. In order to be eligible for funding for a subsequent semester, students must maintain all eligibility requirements.

Procedures

Students interested in this funding must submit a complete application in person to the Enrollment Center. To be considered, all submissions must include the following:

- Completed application
- Personal essay
- 2016 Federal Income Tax Forms or 2016 W-2 forms
- Two most recent pay stubs
- Official high school transcript or GED certificate
- Copy of DACA authorization or International Student Visa
- Academic plan created with academic advisor for Fall 2017 and Spring 2018

If you are not able to provide income tax forms, W-2 forms, or pay stubs, please provide an explanation in your essay.

Each application is reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Strength of academic program, educational goals, grade point average, application content and quality, essay quality, financial need, and/or special circumstances may all be considered for awarding scholarships. Students are notified regarding the decision within three weeks from application deadline and the decision will be communicated via postal mail. All decisions are final; not all applications will be funded.
