Concurrent Enrollment Admission Information

Who is eligible to apply? Only currently enrolled high school juniors and seniors who have a minimum cumulative grade point average of “C” or higher are eligible to apply. Admission is not guaranteed. Notification of approval will be emailed to applicant.

To apply:

- **Review process and requirements with a Recruitment and Outreach specialist.** Call 847.635.1835.

- **Select a course** (one course per semester).

Check the Oakton Class Schedule for course availability, and the Oakton catalog for prerequisites.

- **Complete and submit paperwork *no later than one week prior to the start date of the class.***

Submitting an application online is not an option for high school students.

Documents needed: Concurrent Admission Form and official or unofficial high school transcript.

- **Take writing, reading and math placement tests/submit ACT scores.**

Students planning to enroll in a math or English course or a course which has an English or math prerequisite, must complete Oakton’s writing, reading, and math placement tests prior to registration. Writing test results take up to four business days to process.

Students also have the option of submitting ACT scores and/or a high school transcript for possible placement in writing and reading or math *in lieu of placement testing*:

English – With a score on the ACT English test of 20 or higher and a Reading score of 20 or higher, you would receive placement in English 101.

Math – If you are attending a Glenbrook, Niles, Maine, Evanston, or Northridge Prep high school, submit both your ACT scores and high school transcript to receive math placement.

- **Register.**

Register in person at the Des Plaines or Skokie campuses after Concurrent Admission Form has been submitted and approved by the Enrollment Center. *Online registration is not an option for high school students.* Once a high school student is accepted and registers for class, he/she is expected to comply with the regulations and policies of the College in the same manner as all other Oakton students.

- **Make payment.**

If you are a first time student at Oakton Community College, there is a one-time non-refundable, \$25 application fee that will be added to your account within one business day of submitting your forms. *Payment of all tuition and fees is the responsibility of the registered student.* Please make checks payable to Oakton Community College.

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
